Q4 SUMMARY

Stable biology in the quarter




Stable biological situation, higher volumes, solid quality on harvest volume, and better good lice control

Quarterly harvest volume of 6,455 tonnes, compared to Q4-23 at 7,219 tonnes

- Finalized harvesting of autumn 2022 generation, and started harvesting on 2023 generation in Q4-24
- Q4 harvest volume reflects optimalization of MAB

EBIT for the quarter was EUR 1.4 million, compared to EUR 2.0 million in Q4-23

- Lower harvest volumes compared to the corresponding quarter last year
- Cost level affected by biological challenges in H1-24
- Good price achievement





OVERVIEW



SMOLT FACILITIES

- Have today 3 facilities in operation
- the 4th is under reconstruction
- Capacity of 7-8 million smolts
- depending on smolt size
- Total licences on land is 3.800 tonnes of MAB
- Have sufficient smolt capacity for existing licences in sea
- 70% of production are post-smolt
- Have land and licences for further expansion of smolt production to reach 45,000 tonnes harvest volume. But CAPEX needed.

ISSUED LICENSES

- 11.500 tonnes MAB in Arnarfjodur
- The licence includes 7 sites for operation
- 5 sites in operations today
- 12.200 tonnes in Patreks- and Talknafjordur
 - The licence includes 3 sites, all in operation today
- MAB utilization expected to be 1,09


APPLICATIONS PENDING APPROVAL

- 10,000 tonnes MAB of sterile salmon in Ísafjarðardjúp.
- The application includes 3 new sites for operation
- 4,500 tonnes MAB in Arnarfjörður
- Extensions of 5 sites in Arnarfjörður


